## The Stakes In Virginia **This Year**

Congress's inability to protect fundamental civil liberties from recent extreme right-wing court decisions has transformed America's state houses into the last bulwark of our rights and freedoms.

This November, Virginians have the opportunity to rebuild a Democratic majority in the General Assembly and quarantee that four million Virginia women, and another 32 million women across the South, can rely on Virginia as a sanctuary for abortion access.

In 2021, Democrats lost their House majority by just 971 votes across three districts. Now, Virginia's Republican Governor Glenn Youngkin and the GOP-held General Assembly are pushing an extreme agenda – including introducing a ban on all abortions without exception.


We cannot let Virginia become a model for antiabortion groups and a testing ground for Youngkin to build his national political profile.

In only a few months, House Democrats have the opportunity to stop these attacks and codify a woman's right to make her own reproductive healthcare decisions into Virginia's Constitution. But first, we need to win a majority.

### The State of The Race

Virginia Democrats currently hold 48 of the 100 seats in the House, just three away from a majority. New district maps create a unique opportunity for Democrats to win back the majority. Analysis of the 2020 election shows that President Biden won 60 of these newlydrawn seats.

#### **OUR GOAL: A LASTING MAJORITY**



While Democrats have a clear roadmap to building a lasting majority, clear obstacles remain.

Governor Youngkin has already personally spent tens of millions of dollars to build his political operation. He reportedly believes holding the Republican majority in the General Assembly is critical to his presidential aspirations and is prepared to spend millions to maintain GOP rule.

#### **Meet Dan Helmer**

Virginia Delegate and Vice Chair for Outreach, Dan Helmer, created Secure Progress PAC to fund and organize efforts to retake the House Majority in 2023.


